OLD BUSINESS:

- Discussion: Tranistioning Newtown Inventory System (NIS) to a Newtown cloud. Al Miles indicated that if he can be provided a cost estimate he will make arrangements to move the NIS prototype system to a Newtown Azure cloud. Graham C indicated \$50.00 per month would cover the charges.
- Discussion Newtown Building Documents Scanning Image Storage
 This afternoon's discussion with Al Miles, Technology Director, was summarized for
 the Work Group. He is proposing scanning, indexing and a retrieval system be done
 inhouse. It would require the purchase of one or two scanners and the use of temporary
 help to do the initial scanning to paper documents stored by various town departments.
 - Fred H will schedule a meeting of key Town department heads: Building Department, Health Department, Land Use. Document scanning will be presented and discussed. Prior to the meeting, they will be given the following questions:
 - What type of documents do you: receive, create and use?
 - Where (how) are they stored?
 - How are they organized? e.g. address, name, case number
 - Grahm C pointed out that the Town will need to engage a programmer to build a simple data base system for indexing document files and their retrieval. To define functions and feature of that system, User Stories will need to be prepared. User Stories would be structured as:
 - Who I am
 - What I do
 - Why I do it
 - How I do it
 - Capturing, scanning and using the digital documents will need to become part
 of the every-day work in a number of departments. A work book will need to
 be written for users.

 Ned S and Zach M pointed out that this effort needs a designated Project Manager
