

Meeting on Draft Curb Cut Plan

Newtown Access Management Study • Rt 6 - Rt 25 - Church Hill Rd.



Newtown, in partnership with the Housatonic Valley Council of Elected Officials is conducting a 6-month study of driveways and other access points along Route 6, portions of Route 25, and Church Hill Road in town. The study began in May of this year and will wrap up in October.

The purpose of the study is to achieve better safety, traffic flow, and ease of access to businesses and homes by improving how driveways intersect with the road. The study's end result will be a Curb-cut and Access Management Plan for these heavily traveled roadways in town. Once finalized, the plan will include recommendations for changes to the Town of Newtown's Zoning Regulations, as they pertain to access, and a curb-cut plan to be used as a reference guide for future driveway activities.

The study has been guided by a Technical Advisory Committee (TAC). Members of the TAC include Town staff and representatives from key boards and commissions, local business associations, as well as representative property owners within the study corridors.

The Technical Advisory Committee invites the public to attend a meeting to hear about study findings, and

review and comment on the Draft Curb-cut and Access Management Plan. The committee wants public feedback about the draft plan before it is finalized and sent to the Planning and Zoning Commission for review.
