Recommendation

This junction **does** appear to meet warrant #2 of the MUTCD criteria for a stop sign, which suggests posting stop signs "On street entering through highway". The location of the **current stop sign** on Glenmor Dr. does **not meet** that recommendation. While the name of the "through highway" at this junction changes from Glenmor Dr. to Taunton Ridge Rd., it does not negate the fact that traffic proceeding South on Taunton Ridge Rd. is still entering a "through highway". The recommendation in this instance would be to post a stop sign to traffic proceeding South on Taunton Ridge Rd. at the junction, and remove it from Glenmor Dr. Should it be deemed desirable that the stop sign on Glenmor Dr. at this junction remain, the MUTCD recommendation is to install sub mount plaques (w4-46p and w4-4ap respectively) on the stop sign posts, advising highway users that the junction is not a three way stop.
