

THE FOLLOWING MINUTES RE SUBJECT TO APPROVAL BY THE BOARD OF  
SELECTMEN

The Board of Selectmen held a regular meeting Monday, October 18, 2021. The meeting was held in the Council Chambers at the Newtown Municipal Center. First Selectman Rosenthal called the meeting to order at 7:30p.m.

**PRESENT:** First Selectman Daniel C. Rosenthal, Selectman Maureen Crick Owen and Selectman Jeff Capeci.

**VOTER COMMENTS:** none.

**ACCEPTANCE OF THE MINUTES:** Selectman Crick Owen moved to accept the regular meeting minutes of October 4, 2021. Selectman Capeci seconded. All in favor.

**Discussion and possible action:**

**1. Subdivision Road Bond Reduction:** Selectman Crick Owen moved the road bond reduction for Deer Hill Drive, "The Preserve at Newtown, Open Space Conservation" Subdivision, from \$468,760 to \$140,628, which represents a 70% reduction of the bond. Selectman Capeci seconded. All in favor.

**2. Appointments/Reappointments/Vacancies/Openings:** Selectman Crick Owen moved the appointment of Dana Myjak (R), to the Sustainable Energy Commission for a term to expire 1/6/23 and the appointment of Xiao Han (U), as an alternate on the Commission on Aging for a term to expire 1/6/22. Selectman Capeci seconded. All in favor.

**3. Driveway Bond Release/Extension:** Selectman Crick Owen moved the driveway bond release for Mike D'Amato, 3 Maranello Drive, M33, B5, L18.6 in the amount of \$1,000. Selectman Capeci seconded. All in favor.

**4. Tax Refunds:** Selectman Crick Owen moved to approve Tax Refund #7 in the amount of \$15,420.00. Selectman Capeci seconded. All in favor.
