Ms. Wiedemann thanked all who signed up to help out at the senior center, on Fridays have an intern from the high school is also available to help out. Mr. Symes asked about the search to fill the Director of Human Services position, the search process is continuing. Ms. Wiedemann shared the Receipts/Disbursements Report. (ATTACHMENT)

COMMISSION ON AGING

SENIOR CENTER REPORTS: Ms. Wiedemann distributed the Senior Center reports. (ATTACHMENT) Ms. Wiedemann will be looking for volunteers for one Saturday in July for bell ringing for the Salvation Army "Christmas in July," proceeds will benefit Newtown. Mr. Symes asked about periodic upgrades to the software system, Ms. Wiedemann to look into for more details. Disability section include disability, medical details, and can be customized to input data relevant to each individual. Ms. Frampton questioned attendance at the St. Patrick's Day bingo, attendance was higher than recorded, maybe checked in for lunch and bingo separately.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

GRANTS COMMITTEE: Ms. Bloom submitted the grant last Friday for the ceramics class and will hear by August and funded in October. There will be a kiln at the community center, grant funded. Mr. Symes asked about the size of a kiln. Lynn Welsh, art teacher at the senior center for about 7 years, ran the pottery class, she has spoken with Karen Pinto, expert potter, and coordinated with Program Director, Jennifer Cebry, it was suggested L&L 7 cubic foot kiln. Mr. Ariniello is looking into types of ventilation systems.

Jennifer Cebry, new Program Coordinator for the new community center, was invited to introduce herself to the COA. Ms. Cebry has been a member of the Newtown Cultural Arts Commission and has been the Chair of the Newtown Arts Festival. Ms. Cebry recently attended the St. Patrick's Day luncheon at the senior center and welcomes programming feedback from seniors. Mr. Symes commented he collaborated with Ms. Cebry on the arts festival and found her to be very involved and receptive with activities for the senior community.

RESOURCE GUIDE: Ms. Wiedemann said that 3 estimates are needed for printing and will coordinate with Ms. Rothstein to distribute a new draft of the resource guide to the COA.

I have invited Jennifer Cebry, new Programming Director to our meeting. Join me in welcoming her. She has lots of ideas and is open to hearing our thoughts.

You will notice on our agenda that I would like us to discuss and possibly vote on purchasing a banner along with the Community Center. I will have a rendition of what the banner could look like at our meeting.

Here are some highlights from the 2/26/19 PB&Z meeting:

Doors and windows should be in by the end of the week, tile will start by Monday, drywall and taping is beginning. Permanent heat units are being used for temporary heat. Still a wait for the resolution on main entrance issues.

The next PB&Z meeting is Tuesday, March 26 at 7:00pm at RIS.

Mary Poppins begins March 21-24. There are 7pm performances and matinees on 3/23 and 2/24 at 2pm. Newtown Senior Citizens are invited to dinner and the rehearsal show on Wednesday, March 20. Dinner is at 5pm and the show begins at 6pm.

On Tuesday, March 26 at 4pm, RIS will be hosting a concert for our Seniors.

Dr. Rodrigue came to the SC on Friday, March 8 to give an overview of her budget. Selectman Rosenthal was also present and discussed the Municipal budget as well as answering some questions regarding the Community Center/Senior Center.

We met with Dr. Rodrigue on Wednesday, March 13, 2019. Present were Dr. Longobucco, Principal of NHS and Jessica Ward from Newtown Youth and Family Services. They discussed the activities of the Intergenerational Collaborative Club. Tuesday, March 26 at 3pm, there is a technology help session with this club and our seniors.

The Children's Adventure Center has resumed coming to the SC on Thursday's. We do a crafts, read to the children and interact. Consider signing up and showing up on Thursday's at 10am to help. It's an hour – we have two groups who come over, a half hour is allotted for each group. It's so much fun interacting with these little ones.

Our Center continues to grow – last Friday when Dr. Rodrigue came to present her budget, AARP was also hosting a class and several people got upset that there was no parking! Music to my ears. It's wonderful to see the Center active and busy throughout the day, every day. If you have an idea for a program or would like to begin something, please share your thoughts and ideas and we'll see what we can implement.

Don't forget to mark your calendar for the Senior Citizen Dinner Dance on Friday, May 31 at 4:30 at NHS. Tickets are \$15 PP. Grandchildren 13+ are invited as escorts for their grandparents.

I did speak to CW Resources, our Congregate Meal site to find out what happens if someone eats lunch if they aren't 60 yet.

All the appliances for the kitchen are still slated to be installed in the new SC. There will be mirrors in the exercise room as well as a sponge like floor for impact.

We are looking at options for using credit cards to pay for classes in My Senior. I printed a report that listed anyone who didn't have email. We have an intern from the high school who called all those folks. We have added emails and are as current in the data base as we can be for now.

Update on Friends of Newtown Seniors (FONS) activities and AARP Livable Community Initiative (LCI) by John Boccuzzi was well received - 501c3 Implications & overall Quality-of-Life (Q-o-L) Achievements for both Seniors & "all" Newtown Residents

Transportation was another topic of interest and the WextCOG Report was briefly discussed, although residents-voters clearly are concerned-upset by the Traffic Problems created by:

- Town Traffic Volumes on Rte. 25 & Main St.
- I-84 Congestion Problems overflowing into Newtown & Impacting Q-of-L
- I-84 Danbury Corridor Traffic Volumes Impact on Newtown Commuters
