#### **NEW BUSINESS**

Review claims - J. Spurgeon reviewed Running Claim History and projection vs actual (attached).

Review current status of Self-funded Insurance Reserve Fund and estimate for year end 21/22- R. Tait reviewed 21/22-22/23 Fiscal year forecast as well as claims analysis (attached). There is only 2 months of data for this fiscal year.

Review of Covid related utilization and costs including vaccinations administered – J. Spurgeon provided Covid data which starts in March 2020. There were 183 confirmed Covid cases, and 3 hospital admissions. Total claims related to Covid was 1307. 47% of membership is high risk. While not directly related to Covid claims, Covid did create increased demand for tele-health. There were 3883 tele-health visits and 787 were behavioral health.

Review other information board members, partners, insurance consultants make available- The next meeting is scheduled for November 1, 2021. It was discussed that meeting will be cancelled and a special meeting will be held in January 2022.
