**HOURS OF OPERATION AT
DRYSTALL MARINA**

Hours - Daily

May 14th – October 15th7:00 am – 10:00 pm

1. Eichler's Cove Marina – must have a resident permit for vehicle.
2. The maximum allowable boat length for assignment is: 16 feet and under
3. DRYSTALL ASSIGNMENTS DECAL - The decal for your boat will be with the Warden beginning May 14.
Your vessel **MUST** be on site to pick up your decal. Staff will bring you to a designated assignment. No one will be able to pick up their sticker unless their vessel is present and ready to be stored. Any vessel stored before May 14th will be pulled and auctioned off.
4. The Parks and Recreation Department reserves the right to change drystall assignments for any reason whatsoever. Any boat that is not in its proper location may be moved and the owner may lose Town marina drystall privileges.
5. Boat owners are responsible for damage done to adjacent boats on Town facilities.
6. Slip holders must maintain their vessels in a sound and seaworthy condition. The Parks and Recreation Department may withhold or withdraw drystall space for any occupant whose vessel is considered in the opinion of the Warden to be unsound structurally or mechanically, in danger of sinking or hazardous to Town facilities.
7. Owners who sell boats during the boating season must make notification of the sale within ten (10) days of the sale. The use of a drystall does not go with the sale of the boat, even for the remainder of the season.
8. Any boater wishing to use someone else's assigned space must first get permission from the Warden. Boaters **MAY NOT** give permission to another boater to use the space assigned to him/her. All requests **MUST** have written permission of the Warden.
9. Drystall holders who vacate their drystall for the weekend or extended vacation must notify the Warden of the days they will be absent.

USE OF THE FACILITIES

10. The period of berthing shall be from May 14th – October 15th. All boats must be removed from the Town marina and property by October 15th. Boats remaining after October 10th will be charged a \$30.00 per day storage fee until the boat is removed. Boats remaining after November 1st will be considered abandoned and will be removed from their slip/drystall at the cost of removing the boat, but not less than \$25.00. The boater will then be charged a \$5.00 a day storage fee until the vessel is claimed and will be subject to loss of drystall assignment. After sixty days each boat will be auctioned off in accordance with state statutes.

11. All vehicles entering Eichler's Cove to use the drystall facilities MUST have a resident permit. Boaters will not be allowed in the marina area without a permit.
12. All drystall vessels MUST be properly tied down at their assigned location.
13. Advertising signs shall not be displayed from vessels, or land areas adjacent to the Town marina.
14. All waste or recyclable materials are to be placed in appropriate trash receptacles.
15. Sailing is prohibited in Town marinas.
16. Any drystall assignee whose space is still vacant as of June 15 of each year must contact the Parks and Recreation Department in writing as to why it is still vacant. If no response is received by June 30th, the drystall may be reassigned from the waiting list.

First allowed launch date - May 14th

Last allowed removal date – October 15th

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Assignments are not final. The Parks and Recreation Department reserves the right to change any current boating assignment.

Suspension of boating privileges, fine, and/or arrest may be imposed for the violation of policies and procedures.
