

The following rules and regulations have been set forth by the Newtown Parks & Recreation Commission.

### **LIQUOR IS BANNED FROM ALL TOWN PARKS.**

Liquor permits may be issued with pavilion rentals for Dickinson and Treadwell parks. Permits will be issued at the discretion of the Parks & Recreation Director. All alcoholic beverages must stay within the confines of the pavilion.

### **DICKINSON TOWN PARK - Elm Drive and Brushy Hill Road, Newtown**

- Open to Newtown residents ONLY from 9 a.m. until 8 p.m. Permit required on vehicles entering the Park.
- Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied and supervised by an adult (minimum age 18 years).
- Dogs and horses are not permitted in the park.
- Elm Drive gate is for two-way traffic.
- Vehicles must park in designated areas only. No vehicles permitted in picnic area or on lawns.
- Bicycles, skateboards and roller blades are not permitted on the picnic or ballfield areas, tennis courts or pavilion. No skateboards or roller blades in parking lot.
- No frisbee or ball playing on tennis or basketball courts, pavilion, picnic areas or parking lot.
- No wading or playing in the brook.
- Children using FUNSPACE must be accompanied and supervised by an adult.
- Tennis lessons by Parks & Recreation only.
- Please use garbage receptacles. Anyone found littering will be subject to a fine.
- Restrooms are to be kept clean. They are for your convenience.
- Please report lost articles or any damage to the Parks & Recreation office.

### **TREADWELL TOWN PARK - Philo Curtis Road, Sandy Hook**

- Park hours are 9 a.m. until 8 p.m..
- Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied and supervised by an adult (minimum age 18 years).
- Dogs and horses are not permitted in the park.
- Vehicles are to park in designated areas only.
- No frisbee, ball playing, skateboarding or roller blading in picnic areas, tennis or basketball courts or

parking lot.

- Children using ADVENTURE QUEST playground must be accompanied and supervised by an adult.
- Tennis lessons by Parks & Recreation only.
- Restrooms are to be kept clean. They are for your convenience.
- Please report lost articles or any damage to the Parks & Recreation office.
- Please use garbage receptacles. Anyone found littering will be subject to a fine.

### **LAKE LILLINONAH TOWN PARK - Hanover Road, Newtown**

- Open to Newtown residents ONLY from 7am - 8pm. Current park permit must be displayed on car windshield. In order to launch a boat, residents must purchase a boat launch pass, at which time they will be given a key for the launch gate. No other forms of identification will be accepted.
- Gates are locked at 8:30 p.m. Vehicles remaining in lot will be locked in until morning.
- NO overnight parking or camping. Maximum of two picnic tables per group.
- The dock is used only for loading and unloading boats. No other use allowed; i.e., fishing, sunbathing, water skiing, diving or boat mooring.
- All boats must be properly registered and meet all boating regulations as pertaining to safety equipment, such as no open exhaust or excessive noise.
- DO NOT run boat engines on shore. The ramp is to be used for launching or taking out boats. NO swimming, fishing, boat mooring/maintenance.
- NO swimming at this park. Parking is limited; therefore, first-come, first-served.
- Please report any damage to the Parks & Recreation office.

### **ORCHARD HILL NATURE CENTER - Huntingtown Rd., Newtown**

- Park hours are 9 a.m. until sundown.
- NO alcoholic beverages permitted in parking area or park.
- NO roaming dogs. Dogs must be kept on a leash.
- NO campfires or overnight camping.
- NO littering. Assist in keeping the Nature Center

clean.....take trash when you leave.

### ***TREADWELL POOL* RULES AND REGULATIONS**

TO BE ADMITTED TO POOL AREA, EVERYONE MUST PRESENT A MEMBERSHIP CARD EACH VISIT OR PAY A DAILY FEE. Proof of residency must be shown before paying the daily fee. Daily fee cannot be applied to a seasonal membership. Replacement of a lost card will be \$2.00 per card.

Children under twelve (12) years of age must be accompanied and supervised by an adult (minimum 18 years old).

- All children using kiddy pool must be under 3' tall and be **DIRECTLY SUPERVISED** by an adult (lifeguard not on duty). Inflatables not allowed. No adults in water.
- Adult swim schedule will be posted. During adult swim, an infant (age 2 and under) held by an adult, is allowed in the water.
- **NO** running, horseplay, smoking, use of inappropriate language, food, beverages, gum, glass containers, coolers or bottles allowed in the pool area, locker rooms or showers. **NO** smoking or loitering in front of pool building at Treadwell.
- Bathing suits only in the pool. Cut-offs, shorts, t-shirts or diapers are not permitted. Infants and untrained children **MUST** wear special swim diapers.
- Beach balls, flippers, inner tubes, bubbles, water wings (any inflatable), etc. are not allowed in pools. At the discretion of the Head Lifeguard, Coast Guard approved floatation devices may be used. No masks, fins, or snorkels.
- Diving Board use restricted to those of adequate diving and swimming ability only (Lifeguard discretion). NO running, side diving or multiple bounces. Only one person allowed on the board at any time. Do not get on the board until the previous diver has reached the side of the pool. Diving allowed only in the diving section of the pool.

## POOL HOURS

- DO NOT visit with lifeguards on duty. All lifeguard stations and benches are for guard use only.
- Showers must be taken before entering pool. Persons with severe infections or cuts are not permitted in the water.
- ONE lawn chair per adult is permitted (areas to be designated).
- Excessive loudness of tape players, radios, etc. is prohibited.
- The entire pool area and locker rooms will be cleared from the first sound of thunder until 30 minutes after the last sound of thunder.
- Swimmers must leave the pool 15 minutes before closing time and leave the locker room by closing time.
- The Parks & Recreation Department reserves the right to schedule swim lessons, swim meets, special events, adult swims and to limit the capacity or clear the pool for health and safety reasons.
- No private lessons allowed. Lessons by Parks and Recreation personnel only.
- If the Parks & Recreation Department is forced to close the pool for health and/or safety reasons, membership fees will not be prorated or refunded.

**TREADWELL PARK POOL** will open the Saturday of Memorial Day Weekend

### HOURS OF OPERATION

11:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m. - WEEKENDS prior to school closing

12:00 NOON - 6:00 p.m. - WEEKDAYS while school is in session

11:00 a.m. - 7:30 p.m. - Saturday following the last day of school through mid-August

11:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m. - Mid-August until the Sunday before the first day of school

11:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m. - Saturday and Sunday of Labor Day weekend

1:00 p.m. - 6:00 p.m. - Labor Day

Pool closes for season after Labor Day.
