Elderly and Totally Disabled Tax Relief Program

The deadline to file for **Elderly and Totally Disabled Tax Relief Program for homeowners is May 15, 2017**. You need to come into the Assessor's office any weekday between the hours of 8:00 AM -4:30PM. Please note that we are now located at 3 Primrose St. (Formerly Fairfield Hills Hospital).

Qualifications for this program are as follows:

- For married couples, an income of \$42,900 or less.
- For unmarried applicants, an income of \$ 35,200 or less.
- The taxpayer or spouse must be at least 65 years of age or over as of December 31, 2016.
- The property for which the taxpayer is claiming tax relief must be his/her legal domicile and must reside at that property for a minimum of 183 days a year.

Please bring your 2016 federal tax return and your 2016 social Security 1099. If you are not required to file a federal tax return, you will need to bring **ALL** income documents for the 2016 calendar year. This includes taxable income along with your social security 1099.

Failure to submit your application by the deadline of **May 15, 2017** will result in losing your elderly homeowner benefit if qualifying previously.
