VNM solar project – New application needs to be submitted— An RFP was sent out for Buy All. The 4 buildings (Municipal, PD, Waste Water Treatment Plant, Head O'Meadow) have VNM already. You can do both on the same building even if it exceeds 100%. If you do rooftop system, you put up what practically works. If you put up what exceeds, you get a paid for putting back in the grid. There are restriction on ground mount and canopy. Those can't go over the usage.
