They were supportive of the designated gift and having ACAB monitoring it, but not changing the ACAB charter provision 4-01 (e). CAN's lawyer is working on the language, criteria, and ACAB's requirement to monitor it.

CAN's prior agreement to pay for Sunny's monthly medications while being fostered, and then eventually adopted, would not be included in the designated gift to the Town. The funds to cover the meds will be handled separately.

All ACAB Board members were supportive of monitoring CAN's designated gift if it's done.
