- Review 2018 2019 Budget


Reviewed and minor changes made by the commission of the 2018-2019 Budget, that was drafted by the BOFC Budget Committee.

Newtown Hook and Ladder is requesting funds from the BOFC truck account in the amount of \$250.00. This money is required for Pierce Engineering to establish the feasibility of two additional SCBA seats in Engine 1.

The town-purchased Engine 1 was ordered/received with two forward facing SCBA seats in the passenger compartment. The two rear facing seats have storage boxes that have been deemed useless. NH&L would like to see the pricing and/or feasibility of the boxes being replaced with SCBA seats. Engine 1 has six SCBA assigned to it.

Pierce requires that their engineers check the compliance of NFPA 1901 and DOT prior to any alterations being made by a dealer, in this case Firematic. The \$250.00 covers the cost of this design.

With the approval by the BOFC of the funding request and the alteration of a town owned vehicle, NH&L will continue with the process of attaining a price to remove two storage boxes and replace with SCBA seats in the passenger compartment of Engine 1.
