Warden Maher thanked everyone for attending the meeting and copies of the 2022-2023 proposed budget were distributed.

Revenues Anticipated from Prior Year are \$25,000.00; Building Revenues Anticipated are \$5,000.00; and Interest is \$1,000.00 making total revenues other than taxes equal to \$31,000.00. The Tax Collection Rate is 98.5%. The Proposed Mill Rate for 2022-2023 is 0.76%.

Alisa Lengel, of 45 West Street, asked if any of the budget line items/monies associated with the line item on the Borough budget are also on the Town budget. Her concern was are the Borough residents being charged twice for a service. Warden Maher confirmed there were none.

<u>Tricia Eder of 58 Mt. Pleasant Road, made a motion to approve the Borough's 2022-2023</u> <u>budget as presented</u>, seconded by John Madzula of 20 The Boulevard. The motion passed with 22 votes in favor to 1 votes against.

John Madzula, of 20 The Boulevard, made a motion to set the Borough's mill rate at 0.76%, seconded by William Eder, of 58 Mt. Pleasant Street. The motion passed with 22 votes in favor to 1 votes against.

Burgess Gaston, made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:40p.m., seconded by Senior Burgess Gardner and the motion carried.
