#### **Process**

The committee reviewed the lists of artists and arts organizations provided by Laura Lerman and Sue Kassirer (appended below), and augmented it with information from the 2015 Newtown Cultural Arts Commission proposal for to the Newtown Community Center (available on request) and from our own knowledge. The list entries were then codified with one or more of the following: Artist, Venue, Patron, Promoter, Conduit, and Learning Center. Andrea will be creating a working document with all of this work.

Step 2) Review NCAC history: What has the NCAC done re: prior work on strategic plans? What lessons has the commission learned throughout the years working with artists, arts organizations, and the community?

The Legislative Ordinance was reviewed, and other historic documents provided on the commission's google drive were identified for this step. We will be be reviewing these documents and possibly others for discussion at our next meeting.

Step 3) Review current activities within the commission to better understand its current goals, benefits, and drawbacks.

## **Arts Organizations in Newtown 2019**

(note: Though most organizations in this list are run and manned by volunteers, they also do pay for printing. Musical organizations often pay for musicians and soloists at concerts as appropriate.)

#### **Government:**

C H Booth Library Trustees: all members of the Board are Volunteers

Design Review Board; members are volunteers

**Newtown Cultural Arts Commission:** members are volunteers

Parks and Rec Commission: members are volunteers

**Town & Borough Historian** 

Unpaid volunteer

**Borough of Newtown Historic District Commission:** all volunteers; they ensure that changes to houses within the Historic District adhere to historically appropriate architectural standards (note: Not every building within the geographic historic distract is part of the Historic District. Participation within the historic district is voluntary. Once you decide to join, membership cannot be withdrawn.)

#### **Clubs & Organizations**

**Connecticut Choral Society;** employs director; members design posters and program; director writes the program notes

Run entirely by volunteers; raises more than \$100,000 per year which funds activities (both cultural and non-cultural) at the Library; Yearly book sale enables attendees to buy books at bargain prices.

Run entirely by volunteers; runs cultural and non-cultural events; applied for and received a grant to engage an artist to lead seniors in creating mosaic mural at the Senior Center

**Labor Day Parade Committee;** run entirely by volunteers; raises money for Labor Day Parade that includes amateur and professional bands and dance troupes; enables cultural organizations to recruit members

**Newtown Choral Society:** employs accompanist and director; enables members (singers) to work with professionals; member designs tickets and posters; professional (volunteer) write program; professional (volunteer) creates and runs website; pays for musicians and soloists at concerts as appropriate.

**Newtown Historical Society;** run by volunteers; supports house and presents programs throughout the year; Town Historian is a volunteer.
