

## Flood Hazard Areas Development Application

In accordance with Section 4 of the Town of Newtown's Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance, a permit is required before any "construction or development begins within any area of Special Flood Hazard."

This application for a Development Permit requires specific information outlined in the Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance be provided to assure compliance with the provisions of that ordinance.

Applications shall consist of the original and one (1) copy of the application and all supporting documents.
