Policy 5123.2 – Summer Work for Credit – This policy and regulation to be worked on by L. Rodrigue and E. Gellis. They are looking into a Virtual High School with online credit opportunities for students for courses that were failed previously. They will reference in Policy 6172.6 – Distance Education – Virtual/Online Courses. E. Gellis noted that the current summer school policy has been as follows: Make up courses are for students who have taken a course and not completed it successfully. Students must have a grade of 55 or higher and/or an attendance record of 75% to enroll. Not all students will be eligible to attend. Credit will only be given to students who previously failed the course during the regular school year.	J. McEvoy will invite Elissa Gellis to attend this policy committee meeting and discussion to continue on this policy and regulation. Once this Policy is approved by the Board of Education, it should also be spelled out in the NHS student handbook.
Policy 5123 – Promotion/Acceleration/Retention - (replacing NPS Current Policy 7-105) – L. Rodrigue reviewed this policy, which included her recommended edits, with the administrators. They also reviewed the suggested regulation and our current Policy 7-105.1 – Retention Procedures. J. McEvoy will make agreed upon edits and discussion on this policy to continue.	Some policy edits were suggested and administrators were continuing their review of this policy and regulation. Discussion on this policy and regulation to continue at an upcoming committee meeting.
Newtown Service Dogs Proposal (P6163.32) – L. Rodrigue is to draft a procedure for Service Animals that would provide a framework for administrators. She will draft an appropriate regulation that would include a District letter – one for students and one for staff members. It was decided that the Policy is good as revised by P. Maher of Shipman & Goodwin.	 The regulation for this policy will be reviewed at an upcoming policy meeting. Updates have come in from CABE on this policy and committee members have been provided this information.
