The State Certified Public Safety Telecommunicators assigned to the Newtown Emergency Communications Center serve the citizens of the Town of Newtown 24/7. All Telecommunicators are nationally certified as Emergency Medical Dispatchers, allowing us to provide every medical emergency call for service with pre-arrival and post-dispatch instructions. Each Telecommunicator maintains their proper certifications through an In-State and on-line recognized recertification process. Total calls received for service 32,147 of which 8,302 came in via 911.
