In September the United States Marshals Service contacted the Newtown Police Department in relation to extraditing Sanders from the Marshall Islands to Hawaii where the Newtown Police Department could then extradite Sanders back to Connecticut for arrest and prosecution. Thanks to the efforts of the United States Marshal Service and the investigation of the Newtown Police Department, Southbury Police Department, Waterbury Police Department and the Pinellas County Sheriff Sanders has been returned to Connecticut to face prosecution for the 22 count arrest warrant.
