### **Tanning Facilities General Requirements**

1. It is the responsibility of the tanning salon operator to assure that the applicable Food and Drug Administration (FDA) & Federal Trade Commission (FTC) regulations are adhered to.
2. The operator shall provide clients of the tanning salon access to adequate toilets and hand washing facilities. Such facilities shall contain pump dispenser soap, paper towels or other acceptable drying device, and a refuse container. Hot water shall not exceed 110 degrees F.
3. The toilet facilities and appurtenances shall be maintained in a sanitary condition and working order.
4. Each client shall always have access to a safe and sanitary supply of drinking water.
5. All surfaces that encounter the client shall be disinfected after each use. Disinfection shall be carried out using an EPA registered disinfectant and a single use paper towel.
6. A covered receptacle which can be readily emptied and cleansed shall be provided for used towels, if provided. Chemically soiled towels and linens shall be kept in a fire retardant container.
7. The interior of the facility shall be maintained in good repair and in a safe, clean, sanitary condition, free from all accumulation of dirt and rubbish.
8. No tanning facility shall claim or distribute promotional material that claims that the use of a tanning device is safe and free from risk.
9. Signage with warning/danger statements regarding sprays, ultraviolet light exposure, protective eyewear and substances that may increase photosensitivity to ultraviolet radiation must be displayed.
10. Single user protective eyewear must be available and worn when exposed to ultraviolet radiation.
11. Signed parental or legal guardian consent is required for those under seventeen (17) years of age. Consent forms shall be maintained for 30 days.
