The Town Building Inventory & Planning Work Group held a regular meeting via Zoom, Monday January 10, 2022. Ned Simpson called the meeting to order at 7:02 pm.

**Follow-up From Previous Meetings**

- Last meeting, we discussed that references to the Work Group have been made at Legislative Council (LC). LC may ask for a presentation on what the Work Group is doing. No invitation yet.  
Anticipating the need for a presentation, Ned S pulled some preliminary data from the Facility Table. Attachment A  
Doing this query raised the question of whether Component Group (Building or Grounds) should be an attribute of Facility. Agreed to make Component Group in Facility Table.
- Fred H reported
  - The GIS Specialist is temporarily off work. Should return soon. On return will follow-up with Graham C.
  - Briefed John Poeltl and Health Department on Work Group and need for his staff to be trained in using the system.
- Dude Solutions replied from the questions raised at our last meeting. Further discussion needed. Graham C shared a diagram depicting the relationship between the inventory and the town's work order and invoice handling. More information on Work Order thru A/P systems and capability to change or expand current systems is needed. Tentatively set Friday February 10 starting between 3:00 or 4:00 for a conference (Zoom) with Fred H, Bob G, GIS Specialist, Graham C and Dude Solutions (technical folks).

**Discussion: Purpose, design and development of a Town building inventory**

- Discussion of Newtown Information System (NIS) Prototype.
  - Graham C reported that he made a number of bug fixes. All entry capabilities are working correctly. Still a few bugs in document tagging.
  - Discussed workflows for Work Orders and maintenance. Getting the municipal and school district on the same system, capturing costs associated with work orders, use of mobile devices, availability of API and custom fields in various systems, bar codes, and budget impact were discussed.

- Loading Data
  - Ned S has identified some small buildings for which square feet have not been captured. Mostly at parks. Weather permitting, he will borrow a Public Works measuring stick and do perimeter measurements. Fred H is talking to Carl S at P&R to see if they have that data. Carl S pointed out that there is a measuring tool in GIS that can determine sq ft off the building foot-print.
  - Discussed data loading
    1. Work Group do an entry for one building
    2. GIS Specialist will develop training material after using the system
    3. Department staff from Public Works, Building Department, Schools, and other areas will be recruited and trained
  - Decided on doing the new Police Station for the WG initial load at the Feb 9 meeting.
    - Fred H will get the document files uploaded to a share drive so Work Group members can review prior to the meeting
    - To load data we need to expand definition of what to capture for all Systems and Components. Parameters have been defined for some. Fred H suggested that data needed parallels “scope of work” in bid documents and contracts for maintenance. Public Works is currently working on bid packages for the new Police Station. He is drawing from existing contracts for school buildings.
- For the February 9 Meeting:
  - Fred H will check on availability of meeting room at the Police Station and arrange upload of the building document files. If available he will also circulate scope of work for maintenance being prepared for maintenance contracts.
  - Data load for the Police Station
